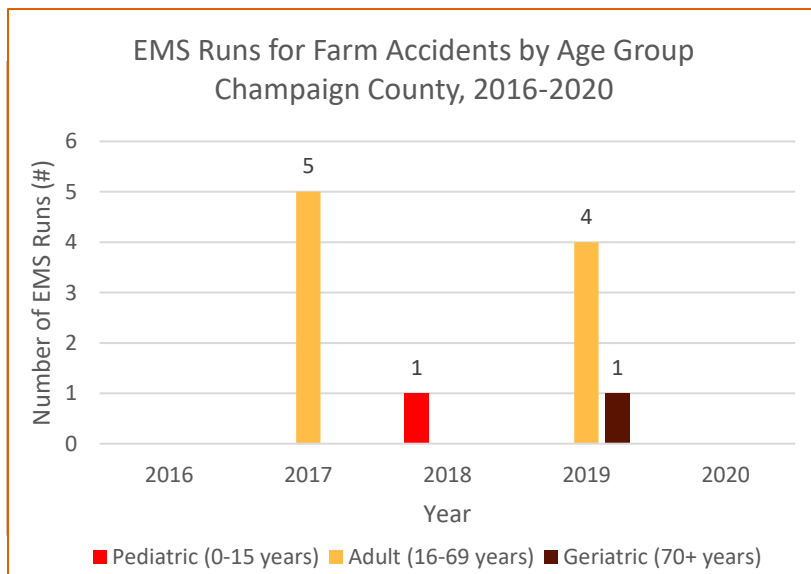
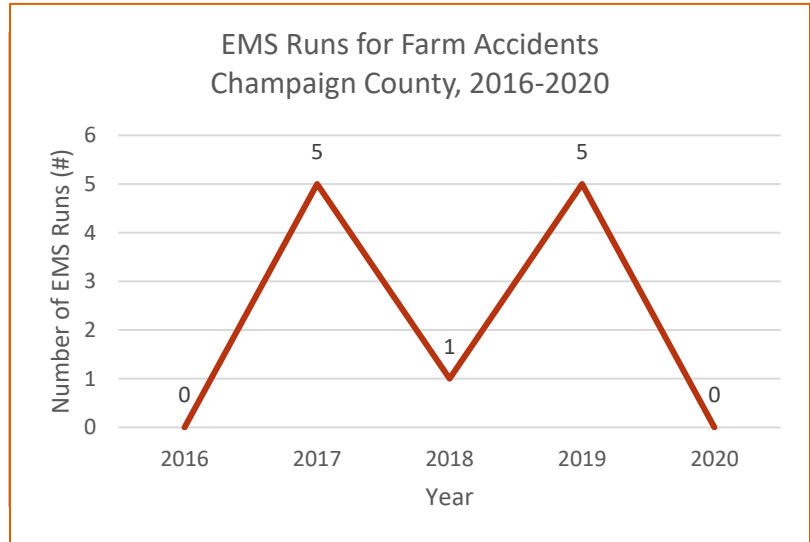


Farm Accident Related EMS Runs: Champaign County 2016-2020

All the data was acquired from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services. The Ohio Department of Public Safety specifically disclaims responsibility for any analysis, interpretations, or conclusions.

Farm accident related EMS runs in Champaign County peaked in 2017 and 2019 with 5 EMS runs. The amount of farm accident related EMS runs has decreased from 2019 to 2020.



Adults (16-69 years old) are the majority of individuals who are involved in farm accident related EMS runs. In 2017, adults consisted of 100% of all farm accident related EMS runs. The only year where adults were not the majority of EMS runs was 2018; pediatric (0-15 years old) individuals consisted of 100% of cases.

Farm accident by type is very dependent on the year. In 2017 the majority (40.00%) of farm accidents that occurred was an unspecified or other accident. In 2019 the majority (40.00%) of farm accidents that occurred were both caused by a fall or being struck/crushed by an object.
