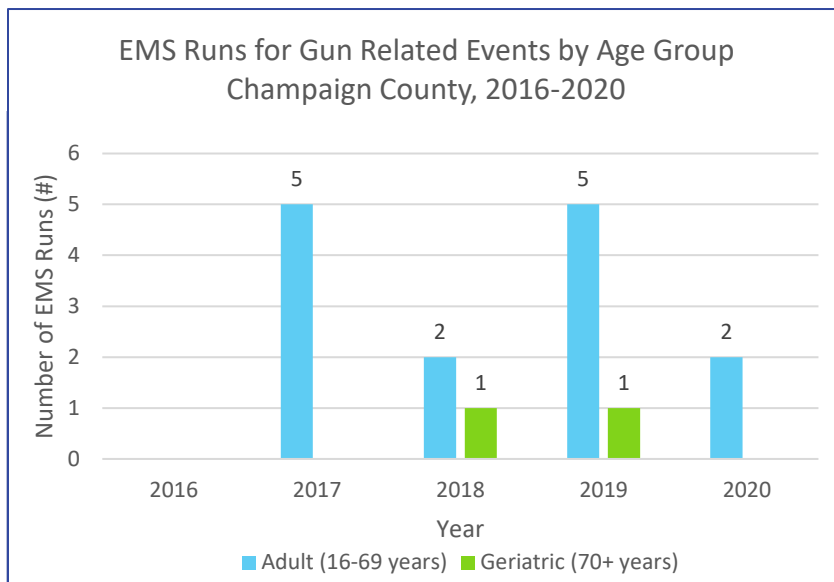
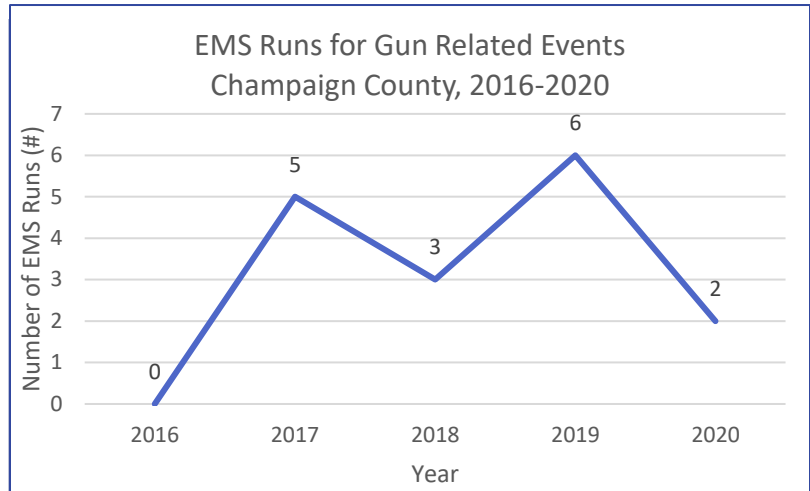


Firearm Related EMS Events: Champaign County 2016-2020

All the data was acquired from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services. The Ohio Department of Public Safety specifically disclaims responsibility for any analysis, interpretations, or conclusions.

Firearm related EMS events in Champaign County have been increasing from 2016 to 2019 with the highest number of EMS runs (6) in 2019. From 2019 to 2020 the number of EMS runs decreased from 6 to 2.



Adults (16-69 years old) are the majority of individuals who are involved in firearm related EMS events. Geriatric (70+ years old) is the second highest age group involved in firearm related EMS events in 2018 and 2019.

From 2017-2019 discharge (undetermined intent) has remained the majority of firearm related EMS runs with a peak (4) in 2019. In 2020, discharge (undetermined intent) and assault had the same number (1) of firearm related EMS runs.
