| | Data Shared by Marcy Ivory reflects 810 flyers for REACH distributed among Champaign County Healthcare providers and only 6 people attending the class. Classes are no cost and patches, gum, lozenges provided for 1st month. A new flyer was recently created reflecting the changes. Classes are 6 weeks in length and participants need to call to register. Coping skills are a focus of discussion. • Discussion on housing & smoking – Could landlords of trailer parks put flyers in tenant's bills? HUD ruling for public housing in effect 7/30/18 that it has to be smoke free. • The Botvin program in the schools has a smoking element • Health department to watch for availability of Creating Healthy Community Grant to see if smoking is still included. • Stacey Logwood reports that smoking in Champaign County currently has its lowest numbers in history but vaping has increased. Vaping increases addiction factor, is easy to conceal, is not on the search institute survey, and there are 2 sellers in Champaign County. | CHD to continue to monitor for news of Creating Healthy Communities grant |
